Speaker Biographies

JAMES RODDEY a.k.a. "DR. DOOM"

James Roddey, Earth Sciences Information Officer with the Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries, has been with the State Agency since 1998. With a background in geology, broadcasting and geoscience education, James works to help translate the often-complicated world of Oregon geology to a general audience. Explaining our relationship to natural hazards like earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, landslides and other geologic mischief has taken James throughout the Pacific Northwest as a featured speaker at many events.

JATHAN JANOVE

Jathan Janove is a nationally published and highly respected employment law attorney who defends claims and trains and advises employers on how to prevent workplace claims and improve employee relations. Jathan is a partner in Ater Wynne's Employment and Litigation Groups. He maintains his practice in both the Pacific Northwest and the Intermountain West. He earned a Bachelors degree from the University of Indiana and a Juris Doctorate from the University of Chicago.

BOB REPINE

Bob Repine was recently appointed as Acting Director of the Oregon Department of Energy. During his tenure as Division Administrator, Bob led ODOE's efforts to grow Oregon's clean energy economy through public investments, recognizing the opportunity the energy sector represents for economic development. He's also served as Director of the Oregon Department of Economic and Community Development, the Oregon Department of Housing and Community Services, and as an elected member of the Oregon House of Representatives.

JOAN DUKES

Joan Dukes was appointed to the Northwest Power Planning and Conservation Council by Oregon Governor Ted Kulongoski in 2004. Joan, who served as a Clatsop County commissioner before being elected to the Oregon State Senate, has a broad base of experience in budget, education, transportation, forestry and fisheries issues at the local, county and state levels, including having served as chair of the Pacific Fisheries Legislative Task Force, an association of western legislators that works on regional fish issues.

MARTY KANNER

Marty Kanner has been involved in national energy policy issues for more than 25 years. Prior to forming Kanner & Associates in 1991, Marty served on APPA's government relations staff and worked on Capitol Hill. Marty has represented the Public Power Council since 1991, and works with other public power systems on individual projects. He has testified before Congress many times and been published in *Electricity Journal*, *Public Power*, *Electricity Daily*, *Energy* and the *Washington Times*. He is a graduate of the University of California, Berkeley.

MARK LANDAUER

Mark Landauer worked on Capitol Hill in Washington D.C. for 8 years and served as a Legislative Assistant to U.S. Senator Mark O. Hatfield for 4 1/2 years. In 1998 he became a Lobbyist for the City of Portland covering housing, economic development, criminal law, fire, emergency communications, public contracting, urban renewal, transportation, finance and taxation among other issues. Mark served as the interim director for the City of Portland's Office of Government Relations. He joined the Special Districts Association of Oregon in 2008.

DANELLE ROMAIN

Danelle Romain joined The Romain Group in July 2006 and has formed close relationships with legislators and administrative agency staff.
